## TEMPORARY RESTRAINING ORDER

This Petition came before the Court on the application of Plaintiffs for a Temporary Restraining Order, sent to the Court on 9/30/21 at 3:11 p.m. prohibiting Defendant, its agents, employees, appointees, or successors from enforcing, threatening to enforce, or otherwise applying the challenged provisions of HB 136, HB 171, and HB 140, pending final judgment. The State of Montana, through counsel, vehemently objects to the issuance of a Temporary Restraining Order as evidenced in their email sent on 9/30/21 at 3:30 p.m. to my Judicial Assistant. Judge Todd recused

himself from this matter on 9/30/21 at 12:57 p.m. This Court was not assigned to the matter until 1:11 p.m. on 9/30/21. The Court cannot possibly make a decision as to the Plaintiff's Motion for a Preliminary Injunction without adequate time to review the entirety of the Record, including all of the arguments, briefs, and transcripts previously submitted. This is a case of extreme constitutional importance. At the moment, the case of *Armstrong v. State*, 1999 MT 261 is critically important to all parties.

Without adequate time to completely review the entirety of the record, this Court cannot enter an order on the preliminary injunction. However, in accordance with the MCA §§ 27-19-314 et seq. this Court can issue a Temporary Restraining Order (TRO) to maintain the status quo until a full review of the record can be completed. The Court has reviewed the motion for a TRO and Defendant's emailed response. For purposes of this TRO, the laws at issue may inflict constitutional injuries to the people of the State of Montana, to include plaintiffs. Any constitutional injury would be irreparable. The TRO is issued with the understanding that Plaintiffs provided a motion for a TRO at 3:11 p.m. Defendants acknowledged the receipt of the TRO as evidenced in their 3:30 p.m. email containing a response to Plaintiff's TRO motion.

The status quo can only be maintained if a Temporary Restraining Order is issued prior to October 1, 2021. Therefore, this Court enters its Temporary Restraining Order until it has had time to review the record.

## IT IS HEREBY ORDERED as follows:

The October 1, 2021 Effective Date for HB 136, HB 171, and HB 140 is hereby stayed and enjoined until this Court issues a ruling on Plaintiffs' Application for a Preliminary Injunction or for 10 days, whichever occurs first. Defendant, its agents, employees, appointees, or successors are hereby prohibited from enforcing, threatening to enforce, or otherwise applying the challenged provisions of HB 136, HB 171, and HB 140 until further order of this Court. The Temporary Restraining Order is effective immediately and will remain in effect for 10 days or until this Court issues an order as to the pending Motion for a Preliminary Injunction, whichever occurs first.
